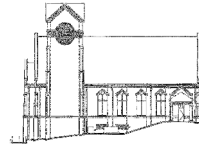

JESUS SPOKE AS ONE WITH AUTHORITY



It was a Sabbath morning and Jesus enters the Synagogue in Capernaum and begins to teach. The people were amazed because "He taught as one who had authority". That is an interesting phrase: "as one who had authority . . ." Authority! Where does it come from? If you've ever been in the military, a highly structured business environment played on a sports team or sat in a classroom, you know where it comes from. It comes from rank or position in the hierarchy.

Sometimes one in authority can overstep the line when dealing with one who ranks under them. A second lieutenant at Fort Bragg, NC was about to purchase a soft drink from a vending machine on base when he realized he didn't have the correct change. He looked up and spotted a passing private. "Soldier", asked the lieutenant, "Do you have change for a dollar?"

"I think so," the private said cheerfully as he reached into his pocket, "Let me take a look."

The second lieutenant drew himself up stiffly. "Soldier," he said, "That's not the way to address an officer. Let's try this again. Soldier, do you have change for a dollar?"

The private pulled himself up to his full height, pulled his shoulders back, saluted, looked straight ahead, and said, "No sir! Sir!"

If we are in a position of authority, we may do well to remember to use that authority wisely or it could backfire on us!
