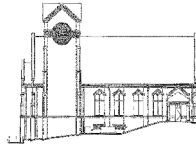

CHANGED LIVES



In St. Paul's letter to the church at Galatia, he describes the change that took place in his own life. He tells that he "persecuted the church of God violently and tried to destroy it." That's important for us to understand. St. Paul, or Saul as he was known then, was an extremist, a radical. If he had lived today he probably would be called a terrorist. And yet Paul changed. He changed so much that rather than continuing to persecute the Christian faith, he became the most influential Christian who ever lived. He even changed his name from Saul to Paul. He changed so thoroughly that this madman, this radical, this terrorist became the author of almost two-thirds of the New Testament. He penned that beautiful writing on the nature of love in I Corinthians 13: "If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love I am a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal . . ." Can people change? If you believe the Bible, your answer would have to be yes.
