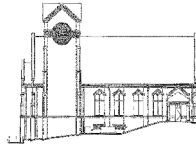


St. Paul is Praying for You!

THE GOOD SAMARITAN

Most of us know the story of the Good Samaritan from the tenth chapter of the Gospel According to Luke. A man going from Jerusalem to Jericho encountered robbers who beat him and left him for dead along the side of the road. A priest and Levite pass him by, but a Samaritan had pity on him and took care of him.

There have been times when we all have been the priest and Levite, but there have also been times when we've been the "Samaritan" and have been of assistance to others.

Journalist and former news anchor for CBS evening news, Dan Rather, recalls an eventful elevator ride in a large Florida Hotel: After having flown in late during the night, he was up early to go downstairs and make a speech before several thousand people. In no mood to be the center of attention, he said, in the elevator, I felt all eyes on me. He thought to himself: Didn't any of these people's mother teach them that it's rude to stare? The elevator soon reached the lobby and as it empties, a woman gently takes hold of his sleeve. "Mr. Rather," she says quietly, "I don't mean to intrude." She looks around; making sure no one else is listening. "I don't want this to be embarrassing, but your fly is unzipped and a piece of your shirt-tail is sticking out through it." She then smiled and walked off the elevator leaving Rather to tidy up before going on stage to make his speech.

When the opportunity presents itself, be a "Good Samaritan" and always show acts of kindness.
