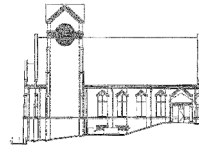

*They also have another great grandchild due later this month!!*

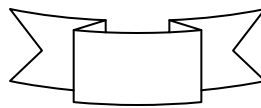
